Aloha Chair Dela Cruz, Chair Keohokalole, Vice-Chair Moriwaki, Vice-Chair Fukunaga, and committee members:

I am Major General Stephen Logan, Adjutant General and Director of the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency, State of Hawaii, Department of Defense.

The Department of Defense provides written testimony in **SUPPORT** of SB88.

We sincerely appreciate the introduction of this measure by Senator Elefante and are in full concurrence of the bill's language, which ensures that all of our Hawaii National Guard (HING) servicemembers and their families will have complete medical coverage that is equivalent and aligned with federal active duty service when they are ordered to State Active Duty (SAD) for extended periods of time exceeding 30 days in support of the State.

We would like to share that recent increases in natural disasters throughout the State have resulted in an increased number of HING servicemembers being ordered to SAD for extended periods. As a result, many servicemembers have been required to take indefinite leaves of absence from their civilian employment, which can create challenges

regarding their healthcare coverage. While some civilian employers may choose to continue paying their employees' company-provided healthcare premiums during an absence when on SAD, this is not universally the case. Consequently, HING servicemembers risk losing their healthcare benefits after 30 days of being on SAD orders. This situation forces them to continuously evaluate their ability to serve without healthcare coverage or to seek termination of their SAD orders to maintain their company-provided healthcare for themselves and their families.

This bill will help ensure complete healthcare coverage for all HING servicemembers and their families and support an uninterrupted HING response force capability to the State.
