**1. to strike the existing exemption for treatment plants just because they produce undefined "clean energy pursuant to section 196-10.5."** That is not a sufficient basis for exempting treatment plants from water pollution requirements.

2. to remove an exemption for treatment plants with capacity below some number of gallons per day. Small capacity is not a sufficient basis for exempting treatment plants from water pollution requirements.
