## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AGRIBUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 163D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended as follows:		
3	1. By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted		
4	and to read:		
5	""Agricultural tourism" means commercial activity conducted		
6	on a working farm, or a farming operation as defined in section		
7	165-2, for the enjoyment, education, or involvement of visitors;		
8	provided that:		
9	(1) The agricultural tourism activity is accessory and		
10	secondary to the principal agricultural use, which		
11	shall constitute at least seventy-five per cent of the		
12	total farming activity; and		
13	(2) Agricultural tourism shall not interfere with farm		
14	operations of adjacent or surrounding farms."		
15	2. By amending the definition of "enterprise" to read:		
16	""Enterprise" means a business with its principal place of		
17	business in Hawaii[ <del>, which</del> ] that is, or proposes to be, engaged		

1	in agricu	ltural crop development, development of new value-added	
2	products,	enhancement of existing agricultural commodities, and	
3	the application of existing agricultural appurtenant facilities		
4	to productive uses; provided that [the]:		
5	(1)	The majority of whatever the corporation produces	
6		shall be produced for export [-]; and	
7	(2)	Agricultural tourism activities shall not exceed	
8		twenty-five per cent of the total farming operation,	
9		with at least seventy-five per cent dedicated to	
10		active crop production or livestock farming.	
11	"Enterprise" includes a business engaged in agricultural		
12	tourism."		
13	SECTION 2. All rights, powers, functions, and duties of		
14	the agricultural development division of the department of		
15	agriculture are transferred to the agribusiness development		
16	corporation.		
17	All	rules, policies, procedures, guidelines, and other	
18	material a	adopted or developed by the department of agriculture	
19	to impleme	ent provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes that are	

reenacted or made applicable to the agricultural development

division of the department of agriculture of by this Act shall

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- 1 remain in full force and effect until amended or repealed by the
- 2 agribusiness development corporation pursuant to chapter 91,
- 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 4 In the interim, every reference to the department of
- 5 agriculture or chairperson of the board of agriculture in those
- 6 rules, policies, procedures, quidelines, and other material is
- 7 amended to refer to the agribusiness development corporation or
- 8 executive director of the agribusiness development corporation,
- 9 as appropriate.
- 10 All deeds, leases, contracts, loans, agreements, permits,
- 11 or other documents executed or entered into by or on behalf of
- 12 the agricultural development division of the department of
- 13 agriculture, pursuant to the provisions of the Hawaii Revised
- 14 Statutes, that are reenacted or made applicable to the
- 15 agricultural development division of the department of
- 16 agriculture by this Act shall remain in full force and effect.
- 17 Upon the effective date of this Act, every reference to the
- 18 department of agriculture or the chairperson of the board of
- 19 agriculture therein shall be construed as a reference to the
- 20 agribusiness development corporation or the executive director
- 21 of the agribusiness development corporation, as appropriate.

1 All appropriations, records, equipment, machines, files, 2 supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents, maps, and other 3 personal property heretofore made, used, acquired, or held by 4 the agricultural development division of the department of 5 agriculture relating to the functions transferred to the 6 agribusiness development corporation shall be transferred with 7 the functions to which they relate. 8 All officers and employees whose functions are transferred 9 by this Act shall be transferred with their functions and shall 10 continue to perform their regular duties upon their transfer, 11 subject to the state personnel laws and this Act. 12 No officer or employee of the State having tenure shall 13 suffer any loss of salary, seniority, prior service credit, 14 vacation, sick leave, or other employee benefit or privilege as 15 a consequence of this Act, and such officer or employee may be 16 transferred or appointed to a civil service position without the 17 necessity of examination; provided that the officer or employee 18 possesses the minimum qualifications for the position to which 19 transferred or appointed; and provided that subsequent changes 20 in status may be made pursuant to applicable civil service and 21 compensation laws.

- 1 An officer or employee of the State who does not have
- 2 tenure and who may be transferred or appointed to a civil
- 3 service position as a consequence of this Act shall become a
- 4 civil service employee without the loss of salary, seniority,
- 5 prior service credit, vacation, sick leave, or other employee
- 6 benefits or privileges and without the necessity of examination;
- 7 provided that such officer or employee possesses the minimum
- 8 qualifications for the position to which transferred or
- 9 appointed.
- 10 If an office or position held by an officer or employee
- 11 having tenure is abolished, the officer or employee shall not
- 12 thereby be separated from public employment, but shall remain in
- 13 the employment of the State with the same pay and classification
- 14 and shall be transferred to some other office or position for
- 15 which the officer or employee is eligible under the personnel
- 16 laws of the State as determined by the head of the department or
- 17 the governor.
- 18 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
