A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENTAL DATA SHARING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the statewide 2 longitudinal data system stores and analyzes career and 3 technical education data it receives from all state educational 4 systems and workforce training agencies to support research and 5 evaluation that will improve outcomes throughout the early 6 education to workforce pipeline. The legislature also finds 7 that while other state agencies are included to provide data as 8 appropriate, the determination of whether or not data from 9 another department is appropriate is left to the department of 10 education, the executive office on early learning, the 11 university of Hawaii, the department of labor and industrial 12 relations, and the department of human services.

13 The legislature further finds that data currently collected 14 by state educational systems and workforce training agencies 15 does not include information from certain segments of Hawaii's 16 workforce, such as those who are self-employed. This leaves the 17 current workforce data incomplete. Gathering data from tax

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1 filings of those who are self-employed will provide a more 2 accurate analysis of Hawaii's workforce. 3 The purpose of this Act is to include the department of 4 taxation in the departmental data sharing to allow for a more 5 accurate analysis of Hawaii's workforce. 6 SECTION 2. Section 27-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended as follows: 8 1. By amending subsections (a) and (b) to read: 9 "(a) The department of education, the executive office on 10 early learning, the [University] university of Hawaii, the 11 department of labor and industrial relations, the department of 12 human services, the department of taxation, and other state 13 agencies, as appropriate, shall share data through the statewide 14 longitudinal data system to support research and evaluation that 15 will improve outcomes throughout the early education to 16 workforce pipeline. The data to be shared shall be determined 17 jointly by the department of education, the executive office on 18 early learning, the [University] university of Hawaii, the 19 department of labor and industrial relations, the department of 20 human services, the department of taxation, and other state 21 agencies, as appropriate, and shall be shared no less than

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1	annually[+], provided that any data provided by the department
2	of taxation shall also be aggregated or anonymized.
3	(b) The department of education, the executive office on
4	early learning, the [University] <u>university</u> of Hawaii, the
5	department of labor and industrial relations, the department of
6	human services, the department of taxation, and other state
7	agencies, as appropriate, shall share data in a manner that
8	safeguards the confidentiality of student education records, as
9	defined by the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy
10	Act, and workforce data, as provided by applicable federal and
11	state laws, rules, and regulations."
12	2. By amending subsections (d) and (e) to read:
13	"(d) All data shared by or with the department of human
14	services, department of taxation, department of education,
15	public charter school authorizers, public charter schools,
16	executive office on early learning, and other entities as
17	required by statute shall be subject to any state or federal
18	laws and any administrative rule regarding privacy adopted by
19	the department or agency that collected the data.
20	(e) The department of education, the executive office on
21	early learning, the [University] <u>university</u> of Hawaii, the

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1 department of labor and industrial relations, the department of 2 human services, <u>the department of taxation</u>, and other state 3 agencies, as appropriate, shall partner to collectively govern 4 the statewide longitudinal data system and determine protocols 5 to: 6 (1) Prioritize analyses and research questions that will

7 provide information to improve educational and 8 workforce outcomes and policies; and 9 (2)Approve requests for access to data provided by the 10 department of education, the executive office on early 11 learning, the [University] university of Hawaii, the 12 department of labor and industrial relations, the 13 department of human services, the department of 14 taxation, and other state agencies, as appropriate." 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
