A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHER COMPENSATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-627, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§302A-627 [Credit] Salary ratings of entering or
- 4 reentering teachers; credit for military service. (a)
- 5 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any teacher with more
- 6 than one year of teaching experience, licensed by the Hawaii
- 7 teacher standards board, and who is entering or reentering the
- 8 service of the department shall have the teacher's salary
- 9 rating, as determined by the personnel executive of the
- 10 department, that is equal to the salary ratings held by an
- 11 incumbent teacher in the department with identical number of
- 12 years of experience. The department shall recognize prior
- 13 teaching experience, whether in the State or otherwise, at an
- 14 equivalent rate to incumbent teachers employed by the
- 15 department. The department shall not limit the number of years
- 16 of prior teaching experience to be recognized under this
- 17 subsection.



- 1 (b) Any teacher who served on active duty with the armed
- 2 forces of the United States shall be given credit by the
- 3 department for the teacher's military service in the
- 4 determination of the teacher's salary, the teacher's eligibility
- 5 for leaves of absence, and for all other purposes of seniority.
- 6 Both reentering and entering teachers shall have each year of
- 7 their military service or six months thereof credited as a year
- 8 of teaching experience; provided that no more than four years of
- 9 credit for military service shall be allowed. Evidence of
- 10 military service shall be by certificate."
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
