BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 329-123, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3	"(c) Primary caregivers shall register with the department
4	of health. [Every] \underline{A} primary caregiver [shall] \underline{may} be
5	responsible for the care of [only] more than one qualifying
6	patient at any given time[, unless the primary caregiver is the
7	parent, guardian, or person having legal custody of more than
8	one minor qualifying patient, in which case the primary
9	caregiver may be responsible for the care of more than one minor
10	qualifying patient at any given time; provided that the primary
11	caregiver is the parent, guardian, or person having legal
12	custody of all of the primary caregiver's qualifying patients].
13	The department of health may permit registration of up to two
14	primary caregivers for a minor qualifying patient; provided that
15	both primary caregivers are the parent, guardian, or person
16	having legal custody of the minor qualifying patient."
