A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE IMMERSION EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- ${f 1}$ SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the "Ewa Moku Kula
- 2 Kaiapuni Act of 2025".
- 3 SECTION 2. The legislature recognizes that Article X,
- 4 section 4 of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii requires
- 5 the State to "promote the study of Hawaiian culture, history and
- 6 language", and imposes on the State a duty to "provide for a
- 7 Hawaiian education program consisting of language, culture and
- 8 history in the public schools".
- 9 The legislature also recognizes that the Ewa district of
- 10 Oahu is experiencing a significant growth in its population, but
- 11 lacks a permanent Hawaiian language immersion school that serves
- 12 students in grades kindergarten through twelve. However, the
- 13 vision of the Ewa Moku education movement is to establish, by
- 14 the 2028-2029 school year, a self-contained Kula Kaiapuni
- 15 Hawaiian language immersion school in Kapolei that serves
- 16 students in those grades. The school would help meet the
- 17 growing need and demand for Hawaiian language immersion



- 1 education in the Ewa District and the neighboring moku of
- 2 Waianae and Waialua. This goal is not unattainable, as
- 3 evidenced by the Campbell-Kapolei complex area superintendent's
- 4 2022 verbal commitment to the Education Ewa Moku Hui Makua to
- 5 create such a school within five to seven years.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to fulfill the State's
- 7 constitutional obligation to provide students with Hawaiian
- 8 language education programs by:
- 9 (1) Requiring the department of education to implement a
- 10 plan for a Kula Kaiapuni in Kapolei that shall be
- 11 ready to educate students in grades kindergarten
- through twelve by the 2028-2029 school year; and
- 13 (2) Appropriate moneys to the department of education for
- 14 the Kula Kaiapuni.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The department of education shall
- 16 implement a plan pursuant to this section for a Kula Kaiapuni in
- 17 Kapolei that shall be ready to educate students in grades
- 18 kindergarten through twelve by the 2028-2029 school year.
- 19 (b) For the 2025-2026 school year, the department of
- 20 education shall:
