### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FORTY-SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The director of finance is authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the sum of \$128,553,000 or so much 2 3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof 4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-5 second representative district, as follows: 7 Kapolei high school, Oahu 8 A. Construction of a new performing arts auditorium to 9 promote arts education and meet the needs of west side
- promote arts education and meet the needs of west sides schools, which currently have no auditoriums.

The director of finance is authorized to issue 2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof 4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026 5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the fortysecond representative district, as follows: 6 7 1. Kapolei Parkway, Oahu 8 A. Construction of crosswalks, speedbumps, and road signs 9 on Kapolei Parkway due to its proximity to Kapolei 10 high school and Kapolei middle school. 11 Total funding: \$2,000,000 12 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital 13 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at 14 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made; 15 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are 16 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date. **17** SECTION 5. The sums appropriated for the respective

capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the

department of education for the purposes of this Act.

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1	SECTION 6. The sums appropriated for the respective
2	capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
3	department of Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of this Act.
4	SECTION 7. The sums appropriated for the respective
5	capital projects set forth in section 3 shall be expended by the
6	department of transportation for the purposes of this Act.
7	SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
