
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
EIGHTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$67,515,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 eighteenth representative district, as follows:

7 1. Kaiser high school, Oahu

8 A. Modernize network infrastructure and unified
9 communications to provide for outdoor speakers, indoor
10 paging, and an audio bell system.

4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 eighteenth representative district, as follows:

7 1. Maunalua Bay, Oahu

8 A. Construction of a loading dock on the Ewa side of the
9 launch ramp to reduce congestion on the ramp.

20 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;

2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.


3 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
4 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
5 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
8 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of
9 this Act.

10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
