BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 3 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
- 4 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
- 5 department of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated for the respective
- 7 capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
- 8 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of
- 9 this Act.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
