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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECTION 1. Section 291C-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

"(a) The department of transportation or a county shall consider the following factors when setting a maximum speed limit pursuant to section 291C-102:

(1) An engineering study conducted for the road whose maximum speed limit is being set~~[; provided that the engineering study]~~, which shall include an analysis of the current speed distribution of free-flowing vehicles; provided ~~[further]~~ that ~~[the requirements of]~~ this paragraph shall not apply when the department of transportation or any county reduces a maximum speed limit within ~~[one]~~:

(A) One mile of a school; and

(B) Ten miles per hour of the current speed limit for that road; and



1           (2) Any other factors prescribed by the Federal Highway  
2           Administration's Manual on Uniform Traffic Control  
3           Devices, as amended."

4           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
