A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: 3 The legislature may make appropriations from the fund for the following purposes: 4 To maintain levels of programs determined to be 5 (1)6 essential to public health, safety, welfare, and 7 education; 8 (2) To provide for counter cyclical economic and 9 employment programs in periods of economic downturn; 10 (3) To restore facilities destroyed or damaged or services 11 disrupted by disaster in any county; [and] To provide pre-determined economic payments in an 12 (4) amount equal to the lesser of: 13 14 An amount to be set by the governor; provided (A) 15 that the amount shall be no less than \$20,000; or
