A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL WORKFORCE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) There is established within the department
2	of agricu	lture for administrative purposes an agricultural
3	workforce	housing working group to address the shortage and
4	challenge	s of agricultural workforce housing in the State.
5	(b)	The working group shall be composed of the following
6	members o	r their designees:
7	(1)	The governor;
8	(2)	The chairperson of the board of agriculture, who shall
9		serve as co-chair of the working group;
10	(3)	The chairperson of the agribusiness development
11		corporation, who shall serve as co-chair of the
12		working group;
13	(4)	The chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission;
14	(5)	The executive director of the Hawaii housing finance
15		and development corporation;
16	(6)	The executive director of the Hawaii public housing
17		authority;

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1	(/)	The chairperson of the land use commission;	
2	(8)	The director of the office of planning and sustainable	
3		development;	
4	(9)	The chief engineer of the engineering division of the	
5		department of land and natural resources;	
6	(10)	The mayor of each county;	
7	(11)	The director of each county planning or planning and	
8		permitting department;	
9	(12)	The director of each county housing department or	
10		agency or office of housing and community development,	
11		and	
12	(13)	The chief engineer of each county board or department	
13		of water supply.	
14	(c)	The co-chairs of the working group shall invite one	
15	representative from each of the following organizations to		
16	participate as a member of the working group:		
17	(1)	Hawaii Agricultural Foundation;	
18	(2)	Hawaii Agriculture Research Center;	
19	(3)	Hawaii Farm Bureau; and	

(4) Hawaii Farmers Union.

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I	(a)	The	co-chairs of the working group may invite other			
2	individuals with relevant knowledge and expertise to serve as					
3	working group members.					
4	(e)	The	department of agriculture shall provide			
5	administr	trative support to the working group.				
6	(f)	The	working group shall:			
7	(1)	Dete	rmine:			
8		(A)	The specific housing needs of each agricultural			
9			workforce within each county; and			
10		(B)	Existing government resources available for			
11			adaptive reuse into agricultural workforce			
12			housing;			
13	(2)	Asse	ss existing laws, policies, and procedures that			
14		woul	d allow the construction of agricultural workforce			
15		hous	ing:			
16		(A)	Near agricultural zones; or			
17		(B)	With agricultural facilities in mixed-use			
18			developmental zones;			
19	(3)	Cons	ider any revisions necessary to existing zoning			
20		and	land use policies that would allow the			
21		cons	truction of agricultural workforce housing:			

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2		(B) With agricultural facilities in mixed-use			
3		developmental zones;			
4	(4)	Explore partnerships with private and public entities			
5		to construct agricultural workforce housing projects;			
6	(5)	Identify any financial incentives, such as tax credit			
7		programs for agricultural employers who invest in			
8		housing solutions for their workforce, that would			
9		support the construction of agricultural workforce			
10		housing projects in the State; and			
11	(6)	Study the feasibility of implementing a state income			
12		tax credit to investors who incur costs to construct,			
13		install, acquire, or rehabilitate agricultural			
14		workforce housing in the State.			
15	(g)	The working group shall submit an interim report of			
16	its progress, including any proposed legislation, to the				
17	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of				
18	the regular session of 2027, and submit a final report of its				
19	findings and recommendations, including any proposed				
20	legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior				
21	to the convening of the regular session of 2028.

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- 1 (h) The working group shall be dissolved on June 30, 2028.
- 2 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 3 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 4 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 5 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 6 year 2026-2027 for the agricultural workforce housing working
- 7 group established in section 1 of this Act to gather the
- 8 necessary data and prepare the required reports, including any
- 9 consultation fees and related expenses.
- 10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 11 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
