# A BILL FOR AN ACT

---

RELATING TO TEACHER EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The legislature finds that requiring the board  
2 of regents to grant a tuition waiver to a resident student  
3 pursuing a degree in education for the semester or term that the  
4 student enrolls in a state-approved teacher education program is  
5 a matter of statewide concern pursuant to article X, section 6,  
6 of the Hawaii State Constitution.

7       SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
8 amended by adding a new section to subpart B of part IV to be  
9 appropriately designated and to read as follows:

10       "§304A-       Tuition waiver; student teaching hours;  
11 resident students. (a) The board of regents shall grant a  
12 waiver on all tuition and mandatory fees for a resident student  
13 enrolled in a four-year college campus of the university of  
14 Hawaii with an education program or that offers an education  
15 degree for the semester or term that the resident student  
16 chooses to complete the student teaching requirement necessary  
17 to earn a degree in education; provided that the student is:



1        (1) Enrolled as a full-time student in good academic  
2        standing in the applicable education program of the  
3        four-year college;

4        (2) Enrolled in a degree program that:

5        (A) Results in a degree in education; and

6        (B) Requires the completion of student teaching  
7        hours; and

8        (3) Currently enrolled in a state-approved teacher  
9        education program.

10       (b) The university shall adopt rules pursuant to  
11 chapter 91 necessary to implement this section."

12       SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

13       SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

**Description:**

Requires the Board of Regents to grant a waiver on all tuition and mandatory fees to a resident student enrolled in a four-year college campus of the University of Hawaii System with an education program or that offers an education degree for the semester or term that the student enrolls in a State-Approved Teacher Education Program. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
