### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 206N, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "<u>\$206N-</u> Wireless telecommunications carriers; backup
- 5 power. (a) As a condition for any permit under section 206N-6
- 6 for a wireless telecommunications carrier to construct,
- 7 reconstruct, or alter a telecommunications facility, the
- 8 telecommunications facility shall maintain emergency backup
- 9 power for a minimum of twelve hours.
- 10 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit
- 11 the public utilities commission's authority to regulate wireless
- 12 telecommunications carriers under chapter 269 or to require
- 13 emergency backup power of greater duration.
- (c) For purposes of this section, "telecommunications
- 15 carrier" has the same meaning as in section 269-1."

7	telecommunications carrier the application shall demonstrate
8	that the carrier either:
9	(1) Owns, operates, or maintains infrastructure used for
10	the provision of telecommunications services in the
11	state and has the capability to maintain emergency
12	backup power for a minimum of twelve hours; or
13	(2) Does not own, operate, or maintain infrastructure used
14	for the provision of telecommunications services in
15	the state and obtains network access from a separate
16	utility that has established its capability to
17	maintain emergency backup power for a minimum of
18	twelve hours.
19	(b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit
20	the public utilities commission's authority to regulate wireless

- 1 telecommunications carriers under this chapter or to require
- 2 emergency backup power of greater duration."
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
