

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINETEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the sum of \$64,915,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the nineteenth representative district, as follows:

8 Construction for a fence surrounding
9 the campus for safety.

12 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
13 shall be expended by the department of education.

2 conditioning for campus classrooms and

15 shall be expended by the department of education.

16 4. Aina Haina Elementary School

17 Equipment and appurtenances for the
18 electrical upgrade of the campus.

19 Equipment \$900,000

20 Total funding \$900,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 5. Aina Haina Elementary School

4 Construction for a multipurpose office
5 and health room adjacent to the
6 administration building on the makai
7 side.

8 Construction \$1,500,000

9 Total funding \$1,500,000

10 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
11 shall be expended by the department of education.

12 6. Kaimuki Middle School

13 Construction for repair and maintenance
14 of four restrooms located inside the
15 school building.

16 Construction \$1,250,000

17 Total funding \$1,250,000

18 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
19 shall be expended by the department of education.

20 7. Kaimuki Middle School



1 Construction for the refurbishing,
2 repair, and maintenance of existing
3 locker room and restrooms located
4 within to include flooring, painting,
5 fixturing, and a wall addition to
6 reduce the size of a locker room to add
7 two additional classrooms.

8 Construction \$2,500,000

9 Total funding \$2,500,000

10 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
11 shall be expended by the department of education.

12 8. Aina Haina Library

13 Construction for landscaping of three
14 outside grassy areas behind the
15 library, to include repair and
16 maintenance of existing non-working
17 irrigation and lighting which may
18 include the front grassy area.

19 Construction \$1,000,000

20 Total funding \$1,000,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the Hawaii state public library system.

3 9. Aina Haina Library

4 Construction for repair and maintenance
5 of original ADA restroom.

6 Construction \$1,000,000

7 Total funding \$1,000,000

8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
9 shall be expended by the Hawaii state public library system.

10 10. Kaiser High School

11 Design and construction for the
12 performing arts complex, including a
13 one thousand two hundred seat
14 auditorium with a stage to seat three
15 hundred musicians; film production and
16 broadcast studio; scene shop; science,
17 technology, engineering, and
18 mathematics innovation space; dance
19 studio; art gallery; and graphics arts
20 classroom.

21 Design \$5,250,000



1 Construction \$44,250,000

2 Total funding \$49,500,000

3 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
4 shall be expended by the department of education.

5 11. Kaiser High School

6 Design and construction for modernizing
7 the swimming pool stadium, including
8 installing chemical and filtration
9 equipment, spalling, converting
10 existing light towers and underwater
11 lighting to LED, and installing hand
12 railings to bleachers.

13 Design \$345,000

14 Construction \$2,300,000

15 Total funding \$2,645,000

16 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
17 shall be expended by the department of education.

18 12. Kaiser High School

19 Design and construction for erosion
20 control at Kaiser stadium's west light



1 towers and the fencing, softball, and
2 baseball venues.

3 Design \$120,000

4 Construction \$800,000

5 Total funding \$920,000

6 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
7 shall be expended by the department of education.

8 13. Kaiser High School

9 Design and construction for installing
10 hand railings onto Kaiser stadium
11 bleachers.

12 Design \$150,000

13 Construction \$800,000

14 Total funding \$950,000

15 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
16 shall be expended by the department of education.

17 14. Kaiser High School

18 Design, construction, equipment, and
19 appurtenances for weightroom
20 modernization, including expansion of



1 the existing weightroom and replacing
2 weight training equipment.

3 Design \$250,000

4 Construction \$1,000,000

5 Equipment \$250,000

6 Total funding \$1,500,000


7 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
8 shall be expended by the department of education.

9 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
10 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
11 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
12 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
13 of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
