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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
THIRTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$67,824,750 or so much  
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026  
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-  
seventh representative district, as follows:

1. Waiawa correctional facility

Design and construction for a new  
visitor center to provide a safe,  
functional, and welcoming space for  
family members visiting inmates,  
replacing the current makeshift  
facility, which is a modified shipping  
container.
