A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC BICYCLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291C-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended as follows:
3	1. By adding five new definitions to be appropriately
4	inserted and to read:
5	"Class 1 electric bicycle" means an electric bicycle
6	equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the
7	rider is pedaling, and that ceases to provide assistance when
8	the bicycle reaches the speed of twenty miles per hour.
9	"Class 2 electric bicycle" means an electric bicycle
10	equipped with a motor that may be used exclusively to propel the
11	bicycle and that is not capable of providing assistance when the
12	bicycle reaches the speed of twenty miles per hour.
13	"Class 3 electric bicycle" means an electric bicycle
14	equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the
15	rider is pedaling and that ceases to provide assistance when the
16	bicycle reaches the speed of twenty-eight miles per hour and
17	equipped with a speedometer.

16	wheels except a toy bicycle; or			
17	[(2) A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title			
18	15 United States Code section 2085.]

Prohibits a person under the age of fifteen from operating a class 3 electric bicycle. Prohibits a person sixteen years of age or older from operating a class 3 electric bicycle unless the person satisfies certain requirements. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
