# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part X to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§291C-</u> Speed limits for certain vehicles; penalties.
5	(a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no person
6	shall drive a motor vehicle with three or more axles or a motor
7	vehicle weighing more than ten thousand pounds, except for
8	school or public buses, at a speed exceeding:
9	(1) Fifty miles per hour or more irrespective of the
10	applicable state or county speed limit; or
11	(2) Five miles per hour less than the applicable state or
12	county speed limit.
13	(b) This section shall not apply to a motor vehicle with
14	three or more axles when:
15	(1) Actively overtaking and passing another vehicle
16	traveling in the same direction in compliance with
17	applicable traffic laws; and

1	(2) Utilizing the left lane for the purpose of making a
2	left turn, exiting, or preparing to do so.
3	(c) Any person violating this section shall be fined no
4	less than \$150 for the first offense and no more than \$350 for
5	any subsequent offense within a two-year period.
6	(d) This section shall apply only to a county with a
7	population of five hundred thousand or more; provided that a
8	county with a population of less than five hundred thousand may
9	adopt an ordinance to establish the restrictions provided for in
10	this section.
11	(e) For the purposes of this section, "motor vehicle with
12	three or more axles" means a vehicle with a Federal Highway
13	Administration vehicle category classification of six or
14	higher."
15	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Traffic Code; Speed Restrictions; Motor Vehicle; Three Axles or More; Penalties

#### Description:

Establishes a statewide speed restriction for motor vehicles with three or more axles or motor vehicles weighing more than ten thousand pounds, except under certain circumstances, in a county with a population of five hundred thousand or more. Authorizes a county with a population of less than five hundred thousand to adopt an ordinance that establishes a speed restriction for motor vehicles with three or more axles or motor vehicles weighing more than ten thousand pounds. Establishes penalties. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
