1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

4	"§302A- Teacher, faculty, and student prayers. (a)		
5	Each educational institution with students in grade		
6	kindergarten, grade six, or any intervening grade shall		
7	authorize the school's faculty and staff to provide, on a weekly		
8	or more frequent basis, time and space for students to engage in		
9	student-led group prayer or individual student prayer; provided		
10	that:		
11	(1) No student of an educational institution shall be		
12	compelled, against the student's objections or the		
13	objections of the student's parent or guardian, to		
14	participate in prayer;		
15	(2) No teacher or staff member of an educational		
16	institution shall admonish, discipline, or harass a

1		student based on the student's participation or non-	
2		participation in prayer; and	
3	(3)	No teacher or staff member of an educational	
4		institution shall be admonished, disciplined, or	
5		harassed for either deciding or declining to supervise	
6		any location in which students are praying.	
7	(b)	A copy of this section shall be posted in a	
8	conspicuous location at each educational institution that is		
9	subject to this section.		
10	<u>(c)</u>	The department shall adopt rules under chapter 91 to	
11	carry out	the purposes of this section."	
12	SECT	ION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
13	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
14	begun bef	ore its effective date.	
15	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.	
16	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
