### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOLS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to build a 2 foundation of respect and love for the heritage of the State and 3 the United States of America by facilitating the recitation of 4 the Pledge of Allegiance and Hawaii Ponoi in elementary public 5 schools. 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended by adding a new section to part I, subpart A, to be 8 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 9 "\$302A- Pledge of allegiance; Hawaii ponoi. (a) Each 10 public school with students in grade kindergarten, grade six, or any intervening grade shall authorize the school's faculty and 11 12 staff to provide, on a daily basis, time and space for students 13 to recite the pledge of allegiance and Hawaii ponoi; provided 14 that: No public school student shall be compelled, against 15 (1) the student's objections or the objections of the 16 student's parent or guardian, to recite the pledge of 17



1		allegiance or Hawaii ponoi or stand during the	
2		recitation of the pledge of allegiance or Hawaii ponoi	
3		in any classroom or activity of the public school;	
4	(2)	No public school teacher or staff member shall	
5		admonish, discipline, or harass a student based on the	
6		student's participation or non-participation in a	
7		recitation of the pledge of allegiance or Hawaii ponoi	
8		in any classroom or activity of the public school; and	
9	(3)	No public school teacher or staff member shall be	
10		admonished, disciplined, or harassed for either	
11		deciding or declining to lead students in a recitation	
12		of the pledge of allegiance or Hawaii ponoi in any	
13		classroom or activity of the public school.	
14	(b)	A copy of this section shall be posted in a	
15	conspicuous location at each public school that is subject to		
16	this section.		
17	(c)	The department shall adopt rules under chapter 91 to	
18	carry out the purposes of this section."		
19	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
20	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
21	begun before its effective date.		

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1 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

2 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
