## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FORTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$97,400,000 or so much  
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026  
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-  
first representative district, as follows:

1. Ewa beach elementary school, Oahu

A. Plans, design, supplies, construction, equipment, and  
appurtenances for three portable classrooms to absorb the  
overflow of Ho'opili.

6 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
8 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
9 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are  
10 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
12 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
13 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
