A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INCOME TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, according to the
- 2 nonpartisan, nonprofit Tax Foundation, economies grow as the
- 3 income tax burden is reduced. Further, there are nine states in
- 4 the nation which do not impose a state income tax. The purpose
- 5 of this Act is to eliminate the income tax burden on Hawaii's
- 6 workers to allow for economic prosperity.
- 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 235, part III, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 8 is repealed.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act, upon its approval, shall apply to
- 10 taxable years beginning after December 31, 2025.
