A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAND RESTORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 3 to read as follows: 4 "PART . ALOHA AINA LAND TRUST 5 **§171-A Definitions**. As used in this part: 6 "Kuleana land" has the same meaning as in section 669-2. 7 "Transferred land" means lands transferred to the aloha 8 aina land trust pursuant to section 171-B(b)(2). 9 **§171-B** Lands; applicability. (a) Notwithstanding any law 10 to the contrary, this part shall apply to all lands leased by 11 the State to the United States military as of the effective date 12 of this part. 13 Upon the expiration of each lease to which this part 14 applies, the applicable parcel of land shall be transferred to: 15 (1)The owner of an inheritable interest in kuleana land,

as applicable; or

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1	(2)	If paragraph (1) is inapplicable, to the aloha aina
2		land trust.
3	§171	C Reservation of uses. (a) Transferred lands shall
4	be used s	solely and exclusively for the following purposes:
5	(1)	Ecological rehabilitation, restoration, and
6		remediation;
7	(2)	Regenerative agriculture systems that support local
8		food production and environmental sustainability;
9	. (3)	Educational and cultural purposes; and
10	(4)	Community purposes.
11	(b)	Commercial uses that do not directly support the
12	purposes	enumerated in subsection (a) shall be strictly
13	proʻhibite	ed.
14	§171	-D Aloha aina land trust; established. (a) There is
15	establish	ed within the department the aloha aina land trust.
16	(d)	The aloha aina land trust shall consist of seven
17	trustees	to be appointed by the governor in the manner and to
18	serve for	the terms provided in section 26-34; provided that:
19	(1)	One trustee shall be the chairperson of the board of
20		land and natural resources, ex officio;

1	(2)	One trustee shall be a trustee or representative of
2		the office of Hawaiian affairs;
3	(3)	One trustee shall have extensive professional
4		experience in ecological rehabilitation, restoration,
5		and remediation;
6	(4)	One trustee shall have extensive professional
7		experience in regenerative agriculture; and
8	(5)	One trustee shall have extensive professional
9		experience in educational and cultural programming.
10	(C)	The governor shall designate the chairperson from
11	among the	trustees.
12	(d)	The trustees shall serve without pay but shall be
13	reimburse	d for their actual and necessary expenses, including
14	travel exp	penses, incurred in carrying out their duties.
15	(e)	Any action taken by the trust shall be approved by a
16	simple mag	jority of its trustees. Four trustees shall constitute
17	a quorum †	to do business.
18	§171·	-E Aloha aina land trust; responsibilities and duties.
19	The aloha	aina land trust shall:

(1) Collaborate with Native Hawaiian organizations and

local communities to guide the rehabilitation of

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T		cransferred lands and ensure the sustainable
2		management of transferred lands;
3	(2)	Rehabilitate, restore, and remediate transferred lands
4		that were affected by their use by the United States
5		military;
6	(3)	Undertake ecological restoration and remediation
7		projects that focus on reforesting native species,
8		restoring wetlands, and improving watersheds and
9		enabling the sustainability of the land;
10	(4)	Prioritize community-led stewardship to empower local
11		residents and Native Hawaiian practitioners to manage
12		and care for transferred lands;
13	(5)	Promote regenerative agricultural systems that support
14		local food production and environmental
15		sustainability;
16	(6)	Support the integration of indigenous knowledge and
17		traditional practices into the management of
18		transferred lands; and
19	(7)	Establish educational and cultural programs to engage
20		students and communities in the rehabilitation and
21		sustainable use of transferred lands, including by

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1	offering hands-on fearning experiences tied to
2	Hawaiian cultural values.
3	§171-F Rules. The department shall adopt rules pursuant
4	to chapter 91 to implement this part.
5	§171-G Transfer. Each parcel of transferred land that is
6	transferred to the aloha aina land trust and was classed as
7	government or crown lands previous to August 15, 1895, shall be
8	held in trust as part of the public land trust; provided that
9	the State shall transfer management and control of such lands to
10	the sovereign native Hawaiian entity upon its recognition by the
11	United States and the State of Hawaii.
12	All terms, conditions, agreements, and laws affecting such
13	lands, including any ongoing obligations relating to the clean-
14	up of such lands, shall remain in effect unless expressly
15	terminated."
16	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
17	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
18	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
19	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
20	year 2026-2027 for the aloha aina land trust to rehabilitate and
21	manage lands transferred to the aloha aina land trust pursuant

- 1 to section 171-B(b)(2), Hawaii Revised Statutes, established by
- 2 section 1 of this Act.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 6 provided that section 2 of this Act shall take effect on July 1,
