## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL IMPACT FEES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the existing
- 2 governance structure of the school impact fee program is
- 3 misaligned. The school facilities authority is responsible for
- 4 administering the school impact fee program. Therefore, it is
- 5 appropriate that the school facilities authority board be the
- 6 governing entity overseeing the program rather than the board of
- 7 education.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to improve the alignment of the
- 9 school impact fee program's governance structure by placing
- 10 oversight of the program under the school facilities authority
- 11 board.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1602, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 14 and to read as follows:
- ""Board" means the school facilities authority board
- 16 established by section 302A-1704."

- 1 SECTION 3. The school facilities authority board shall
- 2 carry out the processes and procedures as conducted by the board
- 3 of education to dissolve a school impact district designated
- 4 pursuant to section 302A-1604, Hawaii Revised Statutes, upon the
- 5 transfer of oversight of the school impact fee program from the
- 6 board of education to the school facilities board.
- 7 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
