BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-364, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) Any candidate, candidate committee, or noncandidate 4 committee that receives in the aggregate more than the 5 applicable contribution limit in section 11-351, 11-357, 11-358, 6 11-359, or 11-360 shall return any excess contribution to the 7 contributor within thirty days of receipt of the excess 8 contribution. Any candidate, candidate committee, or 9 noncandidate committee that receives in the aggregate more than 10 the applicable contribution limit in section 11-362 shall return 11 any excess contribution to the contributor within thirty days of 12 the end of the election period; provided that the candidate, 13 candidate committee, or noncandidate committee may choose which 14 contributions to return. Any excess contribution not returned 15 to the contributor within thirty days shall escheat to the 16 Hawaii election campaign fund."
