BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

15			four-year statewide office or to a candidate committee
16			in an aggregate amount greater than \$6,000 during an

- 1 (b) For purposes of this section, the length of term of an
- 2 office shall be the usual length of term of the office as
- 3 unaffected by reapportionment, a special election to fill a
- 4 vacancy, or any other factor causing the term of the office the
- 5 candidate is seeking to be less than the usual length of term of
- 6 that office.
- 7 (c) During any regular session or special session of the
- 8 legislature, including any extension of any regular session or
- 9 special session and any legislative recess day, holiday, or
- 10 weekend, no state senator or state representative shall solicit
- 11 or accept campaign contributions."
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
