13	SECTION 4. If any provision of this Act, or the		
14	application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held		
15	invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or		
16	applications of the Act that can be given effect without the		
17	invalid provision or application, and to this end the provision	ıs	
18	of this Act are severable.
