There is appropriated out of the general 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 6 7 year 2026-2027 for the total plate costs associated with 8 providing free school breakfasts and lunches in department of 9 education schools as required by this Act after federal funding 10 has been accounted.

11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 12 of education for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
