### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOISE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that excessive noise can
- 2 be a pollutant that affects public health. Noise can cause
- 3 hearing loss; interfere with human activities at home, at work,
- 4 and in schools; and be injurious to people's health and well-
- 5 being in various ways. Noise can further annoy, awaken, anger,
- 6 and frustrate individuals. The numerous effects of noise
- 7 combine to detract from the quality of life for residents of the
- 8 State and its environment.
- 9 The sound emissions from leaf blowers and string trimmers
- 10 are a nuisance and a concern for the State's public health and
- 11 welfare. Some leaf blowers and string trimmers operate at
- 12 approximately ninety decibels, which can cause hearing damage
- 13 after two hours of exposure. According to the United States
- 14 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, noise intensity is a
- 15 particularly troubling issue for landscaping workers.
- 16 The legislature further finds that there are viable,
- 17 quieter alternatives to loud leaf blowers and string trimmers.

| 8  |  | from purchasing leaf blowers, string trimmers, and    |
| 9  |  | weed whackers that do not meet the ANSI B-175.2 class |

| 11 | SECTION 2. Section 342F-30.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is        |   |
| 12 | amended to read as follows:                                      |   |
| 13 | "§342F-30.8 Leaf blowers; string trimmers; weed whackers;        |   |
| 14 | restrictions[-] on operation; prohibition on sale. (a) In any    |   |
| 15 | urban land use district, as designated pursuant to section 205-  |   |
| 16 | 2, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a leaf blower  |   |
| 17 | or weed whacker within a residential zone or within one hundred  |   |
| 18 | feet of a residential zone in the State, except between the      |   |
| 19 | hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on any day except Sunday or a   |   |
| 20 | state or federal holiday, and between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and |   |
| 21 | 7:00 p.m.  | on Sunday or any state or federal holiday; provided   |

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- 1 that government entities, and agents acting on behalf of
- 2 government entities, may use weed whackers during the prohibited
- 3 hours in the case of an emergency as defined in section 127A-2.
- 4 (b) Beginning July 1, 2028, it shall be unlawful for any
- 5 person to sell a leaf blower, string trimmer, or weed whacker
- 6 that does not meet the ANSI B-175.2 class 1 rating.
- 7  $\left[\frac{\text{(b)}}{\text{(c)}}\right]$  (c) Violators shall be fined  $\left[\frac{\$50}{\text{)}}\right]$  \$100 for the
- 8 first violation, [\$100] \$250 for the second violation, [\$200 for
- 9 the third violation, and \$500 for each subsequent violation.
- 10 [<del>(c)</del>] (d) Government entities, and agents acting on behalf
- 11 of government entities, shall not be subject to [this section]
- 12 subsection (a) as it applies to leaf blowers. Beginning July 1,
- 13 2028, government entities shall not purchase a leaf blower,
- 14 string trimmer, or weed whacker that does not meet the ANSI B-
- 15 175.2 class 1 rating.
- 16 [(d)] (e) Any county may adopt a rule or ordinance that
- 17 places stricter limitations on the use of leaf blowers or weed
- 18 whackers than are in this section. In case of a conflict
- 19 between the requirements or limitations of this section and any
- 20 county rule or ordinance regarding the use of leaf blowers or
- 21 weed whackers, the more restrictive requirements shall apply.

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- 1 [<del>(e)</del>] (f) For the purposes of this section:
- 2 "Leaf blower" means any machine used to blow leaves, dirt,
- 3 or other debris off sidewalks, driveways, lawns, and other
- 4 surfaces.
- 5 "State holiday" means any day established as a state
- 6 holiday in section 8-1.
- 7 "String trimmer" means a garden tool that uses a flexible
- 8 monofilament line to cut grass, small weeds, and groundcover.
- 9 "Weed whacker" means a gasoline or electric powered yard
- 10 tool that uses either a flexible monofilament line (also known
- 11 as a string trimmer or line trimmer) or revolving metal cutting
- 12 blade intended to cut or trim grass and other vegetation."
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun before its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

### Report Title:

Noise; Noise Pollution; String Trimmers; Leaf Blowers; Weed Whackers; Sales Prohibition; Fines

#### Description:

Beginning 7/1/2028, prohibits the sale of any leaf blower, string trimmer, or weed whacker that does not meet the ANSI B-175.2 class 1 rating. Increases fines for violations of leaf blower, string trimmer, and weed whacker restrictions. Beginning 7/1/2028, prohibits government entities from purchasing leaf blowers, string trimmers, or weed whackers that do not meet the ANSI B-175.2 class 1 rating. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2)

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
