A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOTER REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that voter turnout in the
- 2 State remains low and continues to decline. Additionally, the
- 3 State has a historically low rate of registered voters.
- 4 The legislature further finds that voting at a young age
- 5 creates and empowers life-long voters. Data shows that after an
- 6 individual votes once, the individual often becomes a habitual
- 7 voter. Therefore, by facilitating the ability of those sixteen
- 8 years of age and older to preregister or register to vote, the
- 9 State will be empowering a new generation of lifelong voters.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to increase voter participation
- 11 and encourage civic engagement in Hawaii's schools by
- 12 establishing a process for the automatic preregistration and
- 13 registration of public, charter, and private school-enrolled
- 14 students who are at least sixteen years of age.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 16 by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
- 17 designated and to read as follows:

- 7 voter affidavit containing the information required by section
- 8 11-15 to allow the student to preregister or register to vote or
- 9 to opt out of preregistering or registering to vote. The
- 10 authorizer may transmit the voter registration affidavit to the
- 11 clerk of the county in which the applicant resides; provided
- 12 that the authorizer shall not maintain, scan, review, or copy
- 13 any voter affidavit nor transmit any information maintained by
- 14 the state public charter school commission.
- 15 (d) Between January 1 and January 31 of each year, each
- 16 private school, in collaboration with the office of elections,
- 17 shall provide and may collect from each private school student
- 18 who is at least sixteen years of age a voter affidavit
- 19 containing the information required by section 11-15 to allow
- 20 the student to preregister or register to vote or to opt out of
- 21 preregistering or registering to vote. The private school may

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1 transmit the voter registration affidavit to the clerk of the 2 county in which the applicant resides; provided that the private school shall not maintain, scan, review, or copy any voter 3 4 affidavit nor transmit any information maintained by the private 5 school. 6 (e) The clerk shall determine whether the applicant is 7 currently preregistered or registered in the general county 8 register." 9 SECTION 3. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by adding a new section to part II, subpart C, to be 11 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 12 "§302A- Automatic voter preregistration and 13 registration. The board and the superintendent, in consultation 14 with the office of elections, may adopt policies as necessary to 15 maximize and facilitate the preregistration and registration of 16 qualifying students to vote as provided in section 11- , 17 including online and in-person options for pre-registration." 18 SECTION 4. Chapter 302C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 19 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

and to read as follows:
