## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TIP CREDIT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§387-2 Minimum wages[-]; tip credit. (a) Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, every employer shall 4 pay to each employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate 5 6 of not less than: 7 \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; (1) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; 8 (2)(3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; 9 \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 10 (4)\$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 11 (5) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; (6) 12 \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018; 13 (7) (8) \$12.00 per hour beginning October 1, 2022; 14 \$14.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2024; (9) 15 \$16.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2026; and 16 (10)\$18.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2028. 17 (11)

- 2 credit amount to be equal to twenty per cent of the effective
- 3 minimum wage as determined pursuant to subsection (a)."

### Report Title:

DLIR; Tip Credit; Minimum Wage; Employment

#### Description:

Beginning 1/1/2026, increases the tip credit to be twenty per cent of the minimum wage and requires the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations to annually calculate an adjusted tip credit amount.

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
