A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 67, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, is amended
- 2 by amending section 5 to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023,
- 4 and shall be repealed on June 30, [2025.] 2030."
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 8 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 9 year 2026-2027 for the purposes of Act 67, Session Laws of
- 10 Hawaii 2023, including the hiring of necessary administrative
- 11 support staff for the illegal fireworks task force, operation of
- 12 the illegal fireworks task force, and reimbursement of funds to
- 13 law enforcement agencies for task-force-related law enforcement
- 14 operations, including law enforcement personnel, overtime and
- 15 other salary-related payments, charges for fuel, equipment, and
- 16 storage and disposal of confiscated fireworks.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of law enforcement for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000;
- $\mathbf{6}$ provided that section 1 shall take effect on June 29, 2025.
