A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that access to justice is
- 2 a cornerstone of a fair and equitable society. However, many
- 3 Hawaii residents face significant barriers in navigating the
- 4 legal system. Vulnerable populations, including low-income
- 5 individuals, families in crisis, and persons with behavioral
- 6 health needs, are particularly impacted by a lack of resources.
- 7 The legislature further finds that community-based
- 8 organizations play a vital role in delivering essential services
- 9 that strengthen access to justice, including legal aid,
- 10 mediation, case management, and behavioral interventions.
- 11 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to provide
- 12 increased funding for the judiciary for services contracted with
- 13 community-based organizations that deliver essential services,
- 14 streamline judicial processes, and support the judiciary's
- 15 capacity to effectively meet the needs of vulnerable households.
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so

- 1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 2 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 3 year 2026-2027 for services contracted with community-based
- 4 organizations that deliver essential services, streamline
- 5 judicial processes, and support the judiciary's capacity to
- 6 effectively meet the needs of vulnerable households.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
- 8 for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
