A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 127A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows: 3 1. By amending the definition of "disaster" to read: 4 ""Disaster" means [any emergency,] the occurrence or 5 imminent threat [thereof, which results or may likely result in] 6 of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life,
- property, or environment resulting from any sudden natural or 7
- 8 artificial cause, including hurricanes, windstorms, floods,
- 9 extreme rain events, earthquakes, landslides, mudslides,
- 10 volcanic activity, tsunamis, fires, explosions, air or water
- 11 contamination, blight, droughts, infestations, riots, sabotage,
- 12 hostile military or paramilitary action, disruption of state
- 13 services, hazardous material accidents, disease or contagion
- outbreaks, bioterrorism, terrorism, or incidents involving 14
- 15 weapons of mass destruction, and requires, or may require,
- 16 assistance from other counties, states, the federal government,
- 17 or from private agencies."



- 1 2. By amending the definition of "emergency" to read:
- 2 ""Emergency" means [any] the occurrence, or imminent threat
- 3 thereof, [which results or may likely result in substantial
- 4 injury or of a disaster that causes or may be likely to cause
- 5 catastrophic harm and immediate danger to the population [or],
- 6 substantial damage to or loss of property, or substantial damage
- 7 to or loss of the environment [-] and that timely action can
- 8 avert or minimize."
- 9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
