

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§302A- School safety; school resource officers; guards.
- 5 (a) The department shall assign school resource officers or
- 6 guards registered pursuant to chapter 463 to serve at each
- 7 department school during hours when students are expected to be
- 8 on the school campus. The officers or guards shall be trained
- 9 for mass-shooting response and de-escalation. In determining
- the number of officers or guards that shall be assigned to each
- 11 department school, the department shall consider:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> The size of the school campus;
- 13 (2) The number of students in the school; and
- 14 <u>(3)</u> Other factors relevant to student safety.
- (b) The department shall seek federal grants to the extent
- 16 necessary for the costs relating to the hiring of school
- 17 resource officers and registered guards.

5	SECTION 2. Chapter 302D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
7	and to read as follows:
8	"302D- School safety; school resource officers; guards.
9	(a) The department shall assign school resource officers or
10	guards registered pursuant to chapter 463 to serve at each
11	charter school during hours when students are expected to be on
12	the school campus. The officers or guards shall be trained for
13	mass-shooting response and de-escalation. In determining the
14	number of officers or guards that shall be assigned to each
15	charter school, the department shall consider:
16	(1) The size of the school campus;
17	(2) The number of students in the school; and
18	(3) Other factors relevant to student safety.
19	(b) The department shall seek federal grants to the extent
20	necessary for the costs relating to the hiring of school
21	resource officers and registered quards.

5	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
6	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
7	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
8	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
9	year 2026-2027 for the provision of school resource officers and
10	guards at department public school and charter school.
11	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
12	education for the purposes of this Act.
13	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
