A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOMELANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, under section 207
- 2 of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended, the
- 3 department of Hawaiian home lands is authorized to grant
- 4 licenses for mercantile establishments owned by native
- 5 Hawaiians, such as theaters, markets, or stores, and other
- 6 improvements for public purposes. The legislature recognizes
- 7 that the development of mercantile establishments presents an
- 8 opportunity for economic growth by promoting entrepreneurship,
- 9 creating more jobs, and boosting local economies.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to be used
- 11 by the department of Hawaiian home lands for mercantile
- 12 projects, as well as lump sum repair and maintenance, in fiscal
- **13** year 2025-2026.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 to be
- 17 allocated as follows:

5	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
6	Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of this Act.
7	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
