## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that fireworks-related
2	offenses occur all too often within the State, and often cause
3	devastating physical harm to residents. The legislature
4	particularly notes the recent mass casualty incident in Aliamanu
5	on December 31, 2024, in which fireworks killed at least four
6	people and injured dozens more. The legislature believes that
7	the State must take action to deter the illegal use of
8	fireworks.
9	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish the
10	class A felony-level offense of serious bodily injury or death
11	resulting from fireworks.
12	SECTION 2. Chapter 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
14	and to read as follows:
15	"§132D- Serious bodily injury or death resulting from
16	fireworks. (a) Any person who causes serious bodily injury to

another, or causes the death of another, as a result of the

- 1 person's actions as described in section 132D-14(a)(2), shall be
- 2 guilty of a class A felony.
- 3 (b) This section shall not be construed to preclude the
- 4 imposition of any other penalty imposed by this chapter."
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 7 begun before its effective date.
- 8 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
