### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 124, Session
Laws of Hawaii 2015, authorized the department of education to
continue, until June 30, 2020, awarding high school diplomas to
veterans who did not receive a high school diploma as a result
of compulsory induction into active service in the armed
services or any person whose high school education was
interrupted due to wartime practices.

8 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of 9 education to award high school diplomas to persons who did not 10 receive a high school diploma as a result of compulsory or 11 voluntary induction into active service in the armed services of 12 the United States and any person whose high school education was 13 interrupted due to wartime practices during World War II, the 14 Korean War, or the Vietnam War.

15 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by adding a new section to part II, subpart C, to be 17 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
