## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 11-359, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:				
3	"(b) A contribution by the candidate's immediate family				
4	shall <u>not</u> be exempt from section $11-357[_{\tau}$ but shall be limited				
5	in the aggregate to \$50,000 in any election period; provided				
6	that the aggregate amount of loans and contributions received				
7	from the candidate's immediate family does not exceed \$50,000				
8	during an election period]."				
9	SECTION 2. Section 11-371, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
10	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:				
11	"(a) A candidate or candidate committee may receive a loan				
12	from any or all of the following:				
13	(1) The candidate's own funds;				
14	(2) A financial institution regulated by the State or a				
15	federally chartered depository institution and made in				
16	accordance with applicable law in the ordinary course				
17	of business; and

4	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Makes contributions by the candidate's immediate family subject to contribution limits. Amends the loan amount that a candidate or candidate committee may receive from the candidate's immediate family. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
