A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMAL FUR PRODUCTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that eliminating the sale
- 2 of new animal fur products in the State will decrease demand for
- 3 cruel products, reduce public health risks, promote community
- 4 awareness of animal welfare, alleviate environmental burdens,
- 5 and enhance the reputation of the State.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit the sale, offer for
- 7 sale, possession with intent to sell, display for sale,
- 8 distribute, or trade of fur products in the State with certain
- 9 exceptions.
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately to
- 12 be appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- "§183D- Fur products; sale, display, possession,
- 14 distribution, or trade; prohibition. (a) It shall be unlawful
- 15 to sell, offer for sale, possess with intent to sell, display
- 16 for sale, distribute, or otherwise trade a fur product in the
- 17 State. The sale, offer for sale, possession with intent to

3	(1)	The buyer takes physical possession of the fur product	
4		in the State; or	
5	(2)	The seller is located in the State.	
6	(b)	This section shall not apply to the sale, offer for	
7	sale, pos	session with intent to sell, display for sale,	
8	distribut	ion, or trade of:	
9	(1)	A used fur product;	
10	(2)	A fur product used in the exercise of traditional and	
11		customary rights protected pursuant to article XII,	
12		section 7, of the Hawaii State Constitution; or	
13	(3)	A fur product where the activity is expressly	
14		authorized by federal law.	
15	<u>(c)</u>	Any person in violation of this section shall be	
16	subject to a civil penalty not to exceed \$1,000. Each fur		
17	product s	old, offered for sale, possessed with intent to sell,	
18	displayed for sale, distributed, or traded in violation of this		
19	section, and each day of each violation, shall constitute a		
20	separate offense.		

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1	(d)	The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
2	to furthe	r implement or enforce this section.
3	(e)	As used in this section:
4	"Fur	" means any animal skin with hair, fleece, or fur
5	fibers at	tached, either in its raw or processed state.
6	"Fur	product" means any article of clothing or covering for
7	any part	of the body, or any fashion accessory, including but
8	not limit	ed to handbags, shoes, slippers, hats, earmuffs,
9	scarves,	shawls, gloves, jewelry, keychains, toys or trinkets,
10	and home	accessories or decor made in whole or in part with fur.
11	"Fur	product" does not include:
12	(1)	An animal skin or any part thereof that is intended to
13		be converted into leather, or which through processing
14		will have the hair, fleece, or fur fiber completely
15		removed;
16	(2)	Fur, wool, or other fibers sourced exclusively from
17		any member of the family Bovidae, Camelidae, Equidae,
18		Suidae, or Cervidae;
19	(3)	Animal hair, fleece, or fur fibers that are not
20		attached to skin, such as fishing lures;

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1	(4)	A raw or green pelt, or a dried, cured, or tanned pelt
2		that has not been manufactured into and is not sold as
3		an article of clothing, covering for any part of the
4		body, or fashion accessory, such as pelts or pieces
5		used to create fishing lures or for the repair or
6		alteration of used fur products; or
7	(5)	The pelt or skin of any animal preserved through
8		taxidermy or for the purposes of taxidermy.
9	"Tax	idermy" means the practice of preparing and preserving
10	the skin	of an animal that is deceased and stuffing and mounting
11	the decea	sed animal in lifelike form.
12	<u>"Ult</u>	imate consumer" means a person who buys a fur product
13	for the p	erson's own use, or for the use of another, but not for
14	resale or	trade.
15	<u>"Use</u>	d fur product" means a fur product that has been
16	previousl	y worn or used by an ultimate consumer."
17	SECT	ION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
18	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
19	begun bef	ore its effective date.
20	SECT	ION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.

Description:

Prohibits the sale, offer, possession with intent to sell, display, distribution, or trade of fur products in the State, with certain exceptions. Establishes civil penalties for violations. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)

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
