A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a reliable
2	irrigation system is the lifeline of Hawaii's agricultural
3	industry. To ensure that Hawaii's crops receive a steady and
4	dependable supply of water, sufficient funding is needed to
5	maintain and improve Hawaii's irrigation systems. Increasing
6	weather tendencies of extended drought events highlight the need
7	for timely repair and maintenance of these systems.
8	The purpose of this Act is to:
9	(1) Authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds and
10	appropriate funds for capital improvement projects for
11	the State's irrigation systems; and
12	(2) Convert the means of financing for certain irrigation
13	positions in the department of agriculture from the
14	irrigation system revolving fund to the general fund.
15	SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
16	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
17	thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof

Description:

Authorizes the Director of Finance to issue general obligation bonds and appropriates funds to finance capital improvement projects for irrigation systems in the State. Converts the means of financing from the Irrigation System Revolving Fund to the general fund for certain positions in the Department of Agriculture. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

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
