A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the lack of
2	disability-compatible equipment in department of education
3	playgrounds is having a negative impact on physically disabled
4	youth in the State. This causes disparate utilization of
5	recreational facilities and prevents opportunities for
6	socialization. It is important to comply with the Americans
7	with Disabilities Act. Disabled community members have rights
8	and it is important that these rights be recognized.
9	The purpose of this Act is to enhance the inclusion of
10	physically disabled youth in important socialization activities
11	by:
12	(1) Beginning on June 30, 2030, requiring all new
13	playgrounds constructed on department school grounds
14	to have a minimal set of accessible recreational
15	playground equipment; and

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- 1 (2) Appropriating funds to the department of education to
 2 purchase and install accessible recreational
 3 playground equipment.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new subpart to part IV to be appropriately

 designated and to read as follows:
- 7 " . RIGHT TO PLAYGROUNDS ACCESSIBLE TO ALL YOUTH.
- 8 §302A-A Short title. This subpart may be cited as the
 9 Right to PLAY Act.
- 10 §302A-B Definitions. As used in this subpart:
- "Accessible recreational playground equipment" means
 recreational playground equipment that can be used by physically
 disabled youth.
- "Physically disabled" means having a physical impairment
- 15 that substantially limits one or more major life activities.
- 17 apparatuses that are intended for the recreation of children,

"Playground" means any public outdoor facility with

- 18 including but not limited to sliding boards, swing sets, and
- 19 teeterboards.

20 "Youth" means individuals under the age of eighteen.

- 1 §302A-C Accessible recreational playground equipment
- 2 installation; minimum requirements. (a) Beginning on June 30,
- 3 2030, every new playground constructed on department school
- 4 grounds shall include accessible recreational playground
- 5 equipment as part of the playground apparatuses.
- 6 (b) All accessible recreational playground equipment
- 7 installed pursuant to this section shall comply with the
- 8 standards set forth in the 2010 Americans with Disabilities Act
- 9 Standards for Accessible Design, or any successor or similar
- 10 quidelines or standards governing accessibility standards for
- 11 public facilities.
- 12 §302A-D Accessible recreational playground equipment
- 13 special fund. (a) There is established an accessible
- 14 recreational playground equipment special fund to be
- 15 administered by the department, which shall consist of moneys
- 16 appropriated to the fund by the legislature.
- 17 (b) Moneys from the accessible recreational playground
- 18 equipment special fund shall be expended by the department for
- 19 the acquisition, installation, and maintenance of accessible
- 20 recreational playground equipment.

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- 1 (c) All unobligated, unencumbered, or unexpended funds
- 2 remaining in the fund in excess of \$ at the close of
- 3 each fiscal year shall lapse to the general fund.
- 4 §302A-E Compliance with federal and state law. All
- 5 accessible recreational playground equipment shall comply with
- 6 all applicable federal and state laws."
- 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 10 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 11 year 2026-2027 to be deposited into the accessible recreational
- 12 playground equipment special fund established pursuant to
- 13 section 302A-D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 14 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the accessible
- 15 recreational playground equipment special fund the sum of
- 16 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 17 year 2025-2026 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be
- 18 necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 for the purchase and
- 19 installation of accessible recreational playground equipment on
- 20 department school grounds.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 5. In codifying the new sections added by section
- 4 2 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 5 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 6 the new sections in this Act.
- 7 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
