A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISABILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many state
- 2 facilities are not compliant with the federal Americans with
- 3 Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended (ADA). Compliance with the
- 4 ADA concerns the entire community and fulfills our duty to
- 5 recognize and uphold the rights and needs of our disabled
- 6 community members. Compliance with the ADA is mandatory, and the
- 7 legislature must ensure that state buildings and facilities meet
- 8 the needs of the entire community.
- 9 The legislature further finds that Title II of the ADA
- 10 requires that state and local governments provide people with
- 11 disabilities an equal opportunity to benefit from programs,
- 12 services, and activities, including public education,
- 13 employment, transportation, recreation, health care, social
- 14 services, courts, voting, and public meetings.
- 15 Title II of the ADA also requires state and local
- 16 governments to follow specific architectural standards in new
- 17 construction and alteration of their facilities. They must also



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- 1 relocate programs or otherwise provide access in inaccessible
- 2 older buildings and communicate effectively with persons who
- 3 have hearing, vision, or speech disabilities. Public entities
- 4 are not required to take actions that would result in undue
- 5 financial and administrative burdens. They are, however,
- 6 required to make reasonable modifications to policies,
- 7 practices, and procedures as necessary to avoid discrimination,
- 8 unless they can demonstrate that doing so would fundamentally
- 9 alter the nature of the service, program, or activity being
- 10 provided.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 12 land and natural resources to evaluate and report on department
- 13 facilities that are not in compliance with the ADA.
- 14 SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources
- 15 shall conduct an evaluation of its facilities for compliance
- 16 with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as
- 17 amended, and compile a list of facilities that are
- 18 non-compliant. The department shall report its findings to the
- 19 legislature by November 1, 2025.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
