A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENCAMPMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that encampments,
2	including tents, makeshift shelters, and other temporary
3	structures used for habitation, create a complex and pressing
4	problem when close to school grounds. When close to schools,
5	these encampments can threaten the safety, health, and overall
6	well-being of students, school staff, and surrounding
7	communities. Encampments can introduce environmental hazards,
8	obstruct public access, and pose public safety concerns.
9	The purpose of this Act is to prohibit the erection,
10	placement, construction, or maintenance of an encampment within
11	one hundred feet from the property line of a pre-K-12 public or
12	private school or school facility on public or private property
13	SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
14	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
15	as follows:

- 1 § -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter:
- 2 "Buffer zone" means one hundred feet from the property line
- 3 of a pre-K-12 public or private school or school facility on
- 4 public or private property.
- 5 "Encampment" means a tent, makeshift shelter, or any other
- 6 temporary structure used for habitation.
- 7 § -2 Buffer zone; schools. (a) No person shall erect,
- 8 place, construct, or maintain an encampment within a buffer zone
- 9 of a pre-K-12 public or private school or school facility.
- 10 (b) Violation of subsection (a) shall be a petty
- 11 misdemeanor.
- (c) Nothing in this section shall preclude a person from
- 13 being charged with a trespassing violation pursuant to chapter
- 14 708 or any other violation.
- (d) The department of education, charter schools, and
- 16 private schools may collaborate with law enforcement officers to
- 17 identify and remove encampments within the buffer zone.
- (e) Law enforcement personnel enforcing this section shall
- 19 provide information related to temporary housing and
- 20 homelessness assistance programs to individuals displaced from
- 21 encampments.

- 1 (f) Law enforcement personnel shall take the personal
- 2 belongings of individuals displaced from encampments into
- 3 custody and store them at the police station or other designated
- 4 location, to be returned to the individual upon release from

- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
