### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the state public								
2	charter school commission, as the State's only charter school								
3	authorizer, is required to submit a comprehensive annual report								
4	to the legislature that details the items for which the board of								
5	education is also required to report on.								
6	The purpose of this Act is to eliminate duplicative								
7	reporting requirements by repealing the requirement for the								
8	board of education to annually report to the legislature,								
9	governor, and the public on public charter schools.								
10	SECTION 2. Section 302D-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is								
11	repealed.								
12	[" <b>§302D-21 Annual board report.</b> No later than the opening								
13	day of each regular session of the legislature, the board shall								
14	issue to the governor, the legislature, and the public, an								
15	annual report on the State's public-charter schools, drawing								
16	from the annual reports submitted by every authorizer, as well								
17	as any additional relevant data compiled by the board, for the
