A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FREESTANDING BIRTHING FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by										
2	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read										
3	as follows:										
4	"CHAPTER										
5	FREESTANDING BIRTH FACILITIES										
6	§ -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter:										
7	"Broad service hospital" means a medical facility which is										
8	staffed and equipped to provide definite inpatient, medical,										
9	surgical, and obstetrical care for a twenty-four hour period or										
10	longer.										
11	"Department" means the department of health.										
12	"Director" means the director of health.										
13	"Freestanding birthing facility" means a public or private										
14	facility that is not financially or administratively connected										
15	with a broad service hospital whose only purpose is the										
16	reception of low-risk maternity patients and the providing of										

- 1 care during pregnancy, delivery, and the immediate postpartum
- 2 period.
- 3 "Low-risk maternity patient" means a person who does not
- 4 exhibit any evidence of any risk criteria that will adversely
- 5 affect the health of the mother or infant during pregnancy,
- 6 labor, birth, or the immediate postpartum period.
- 7 **S -2 License required.** (a) It shall be unlawful for
- 8 any group or person to operate a freestanding birthing facility
- 9 without a license.
- 10 (b) Every group or person seeking a license to operate a
- 11 freestanding birthing facility shall file a written application
- 12 with the director that shall contain such information and be in
- 13 such form as the director may prescribe.
- 14 (c) A license shall be issued only to the group or person
- 15 named in the application and only for the premises listed in the
- 16 application for licensure.
- 17 § -3 License; standards. (a) A license shall not be
- 18 issued to any group or person that is not:
- (1) Currently accredited by the Commission for the
- 20 Accreditation of Birth Centers; or

- 1 (2) In the process of obtaining accreditation within six
- months of the date of the application for licensure;
- 3 provided that if a freestanding birthing facility loses the
- 4 accreditation required by this section, it shall immediately
- 5 notify the director of its change in accreditation status.
- **6** (b) An applicant for licensure shall clearly define
- 7 written risk criteria or factors which, when present, would
- 8 preclude a patient from being considered a low-risk patient and
- 9 therefore ineligible for a health care services at the
- 10 freestanding birthing center.
- 11 § -4 Licenses; renewals. Licenses shall be renewed on
- 12 an annual basis.
- 13 § -5 Licenses; suspension or revocation. The director
- 14 may suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew a license if a
- 15 freestanding birthing facility substantially violates any
- 16 requirement of this chapter or rule adopted by the department
- 17 under this chapter.
- 18 § -6 Fees. The director may establish reasonable fees
- 19 for the issuance or renewal of licenses.
- 20 § -7 Rules. The department may adopt rules pursuant to
- 21 chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this chapter.
