
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT, CITY AND COUNTY OF
HONOLULU, AND HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PARTNER WITH
LOCAL BUSINESSES AND ORGANIZATIONS TO CREATE DISPOSAL
PROGRAMS FOR ILLEGAL FIREWORKS.

1 WHEREAS, illegal fireworks use in Hawaii is an ongoing
2 problem throughout the State despite the various local, state,
3 and federal laws governing the manufacture, transportation,
4 distribution, sale, and use of fireworks; and
5

6 WHEREAS, the use of illegal fireworks in neighborhoods has
7 substantially increased in recent years, resulting in tragic
8 consequences; and
9

10 WHEREAS, the New Year's Eve explosion at a Salt Lake home,
11 caused by illegal fireworks, killed six people and seriously
12 injured twenty others; and
13

14 WHEREAS, following this deadly explosion, the Department of
15 Law Enforcement held a fireworks disposal event, which brought
16 in over one thousand three hundred pounds of fireworks from one
17 hundred twenty-one residents; and
18

19 WHEREAS, the event allowed people to properly dispose of
20 their fireworks, as it is dangerous to store fireworks at home,
21 and fireworks should not be thrown away in household trash; and
22

23 WHEREAS, fireworks disposal programs with designated drop
24 off locations would allow Hawaii residents to safely discard
25 unused fireworks throughout the year and reduce the amount of
26 illegal fireworks in our communities; now, therefore,



1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
2 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
3 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Law
4 Enforcement, City and County of Honolulu, and Honolulu Police
5 Department are urged to partner with local businesses and
6 organizations to create disposal programs for illegal fireworks;

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States Bureau of
10 Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, Department of Law
11 Enforcement, Department of Attorney General, Honolulu Police
12 Department, and Honolulu Fire Department are urged to work
13 together to host a fireworks disposal event on a regular basis;

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
17 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the
18 United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and
19 Explosives; Director of Law Enforcement; Attorney General; Mayor
20 of the City and County of Honolulu; Chairperson of the Honolulu
21 City Council; Chief of Police of the Honolulu Police Department;
22 and Fire Chief of the Honolulu Fire Department.
