HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE HAWAII SISTER-STATE COMMITTEE TO EVALUATE AND DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE INITIATION OF A SISTER-STATE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN HAWAII AND NEW ZEALAND TO FOSTER STRONGER TIES IN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, ARTS AND CULTURAL EXCHANGE, EDUCATION, AND ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY.

WHEREAS, Hawaii and New Zealand share deep historical, 1 cultural, economic, and environmental connections, rooted in the 2 3 rich heritage of the Pacific islands; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the indigenous peoples of Hawaii and New Zealand, the Kanaka Maoli and Māori, share linguistic, ancestral, and 6 7 cultural ties as members of the greater Polynesian family; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Hawaii and New Zealand are committed to the 10 preservation and promotion of indigenous cultures, sustainable environmental practices, and economic development that respects 11 12 traditional knowledge and values; and 13 WHEREAS, Hawaii and New Zealand serve as important hubs for 14 regional cooperation, fostering economic development and 15 16 environmental sustainability throughout the Pacific region; and 17 WHEREAS, the establishment of a sister-state relationship 18 19 would strengthen mutual interests in trade, tourism, education, environmental protection, cultural exchange, and disaster 20 21 preparedness and response efforts; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the arts are a vital and transformative part of Hawaii's cultural identity and economy, and New Zealand's rich 24 artistic traditions offer an opportunity for cross-cultural 25 26 collaboration, creative exchange, and mutual growth in the arts; and 27 28

1 WHEREAS, the establishment of a sister-state relationship 2 would foster artistic innovation, enhance cultural understanding, and create new opportunities for artistic 3 expression, education, and professional development in both 4 Hawaii and New Zealand; and 5 6 WHEREAS, a formalized relationship between Hawaii and New 7 Zealand would provide opportunities for collaboration in 8 9 renewable energy initiatives, agricultural innovation, marine 10 conservation, and technology sharing; and 11 WHEREAS, cultural exchange programs between educational 12 institutions in Hawaii and New Zealand would enhance 13 14 understanding and appreciation of Polynesian traditions, language revitalization efforts, and academic cooperation in 15 16 fields such as marine biology, climate change, and Pacific 17 studies; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the people of Hawaii and New Zealand share a 20 strong commitment to global peace, security, and prosperity, making a sister-state relationship an opportunity to promote 21 goodwill and shared goals; now, therefore, 22 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 25 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 26 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaii Sister-State 27 Committee is urged to evaluate and develop recommendations for the initiation of a sister-state relationship between Hawaii and 28 29 New Zealand to foster stronger ties in economic development, 30 arts and cultural exchange, education, and environmental sustainability; and 31 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is urged, in 34 consultation with relevant government agencies and stakeholders, 35 to take necessary steps to implement this sister-state 36 relationship and facilitate ongoing collaboration; and 37 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the establishment of the 39 sister-state relationship, appropriate state agencies, educational institutions, business organizations, and cultural 40 41 institutions are encouraged to develop programs and initiatives 42 in collaboration with their counterparts in New Zealand; and
