## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

## URGING THE PEACE CORPS TO IMMEDIATELY ESTABLISH A MISSION IN THE MARSHALL ISLANDS.

1	WHEREAS, the Republic of the Marshall Islands signed a
2 3	Compact of Free Association with the United States in 1983; and
4	WHEREAS, the United States has full authority and
5	responsibility for security and defense of the Marshall Islands
6	and the two nations have full diplomatic relations; and
7	
8 9	WHEREAS, the economy of the Marshall Islands is mainly derived from United States payments under the terms of the
9 10	Compact of Free Association and the United States Department of
11	Defense is one of the largest employers in the nation; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, only approximately forty-three per cent of
14	Marshallese people over the age of twenty-five have completed
15	high school and only nine per cent have graduated from college;
16 17	and
18	WHEREAS, nuclear testing in the vicinity of the Marshall
19	Islands has led to significant health issues, including various
20	forms of cancer and birth defects; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, years of nuclear testing, overfishing, and climate
23 24	change have significantly diminished traditional food sources; and
24 25	WHEREAS, ninety per cent of the Marshallese food supply
26	chain is made up from imported goods; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, eighty per cent of food imports are processed
29 20	foods which have led to alarmingly high rates of obesity and
30 21	diabetes among the adult population; and

1 WHEREAS, the Peace Corps previously served in the Marshall 2 Islands from 1966 through 1996; now, therefore, 3 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 4 5 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the Peace Corps immediately 6 establish a mission in the Marshall Islands; and 7 8 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Peace Crops coordinate humanitarian efforts with as many additional agencies as 10 possible, such as the U.S. Department of Defense, the State of 11 Hawaii, the United Nations, the Red Cross, and any other 12 organization providing economic relief and food security in the 13 14 region; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Marshall Islands 17 Minister of Foreign Affairs, U.S. Secretary of Defense, 18 Administrator of the U.S. Agency for International Development, 19 Director of the Peace Corps, and Governor of the State of 20 Hawaii. 21 22 Jui Whi 23 24 OFFERED BY:
